### **LODGMET OF APPEALS UNDER PART XV OF THE *LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1960***

Building Note Number 10, issued in April 2003, advised that the administration of Part VIII and XV of the *Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1960* had been transferred to the Minister for Housing and Works.

Accordingly, any provisions under Part XV of the Act that provides for a right of appeal to the Minister is referred to the Department for Housing and Works.

In order to reduce the processing time of such appeals, the Department of Housing and Works requests that all appeals be lodged, either by hand or by post, at the following address:

Regulation 3 of the *Local Government (Appeals to Minister) Regulations 1961* requires that all appeals to the Minister be lodged with the Department. The Department will then forward the appeal documentation to the Minister.

The Department requests that all building practitioners who will be assisting appellants in lodging appeal documentation ensure that appeals to the Minister are not lodged at the Minister's office, but rather, that they are lodged with the Department at the address indicated in this Building Note.
