### BCA CORRIGENDA

The latest edition of the Building Code of Australia (BCA) Edition 2004 has now been released by the Australian Building Codes Board (ABCB) and came into effect on 1 May 2004. This will remain current until 30 April 2005.

In order to further develop and improve future BCA and BCA related products, the entire content has been redrafted into the latest electronic publishing language. Following the completion of this process 12 pages were identified as requiring further correction and, as a result, the ABCB has reproduced these pages, as they should appear within your BCA 2004.

The 12 pages (10 pages in Volume One, 2 pages in Volume Two) containing corrections to the BCA, along with a Corrigendum List identifying these changes, can be found on the Department of Housing and Works website [http://www.dhw.wa.gov.au/policy/policy\\_buildingcontrol.cfm](http://www.dhw.wa.gov.au/policy/policy_buildingcontrol.cfm).
